We will parade up the village at 9.00am and stop at the Old School before going to the church.

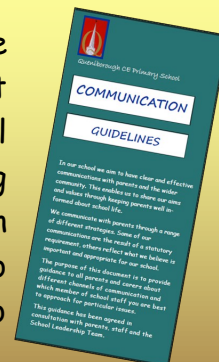
'The Year Ahead' Parents' Workshop
