

Dear Parents,

Each year our Year 6 pupils visit Warning Zone, a fantastic centre, where they learn about ways of staying safe when faced with dangers in a range of situations and scenarios. Part of this experience is the E-Safety Zone in which pupils learn about the issues and dangers they may face online.

In our experience, we have found that many of our KS2 children enjoy exploring the internet and different forms of social media, online gaming and online communication. While this is all a normal part of children's growing technological experience, it is essential that they, and we as parents, understand the importance of staying safe online.

Last year, we were able to run a parent's session at Warning Zone to allow parents to experience the E-Safety Zone and also learn more and ask questions about the E-Safety issues facing our children today. This workshop was very well received by the parents who attended and, as a result, we are pleased to be able to offer another parents' workshop this year to all parents.

We're very excited to be welcoming GB 3x Olympic Swimmer Jo Jackson to our school Joanne has represented Great Britain at 3 Olympic Games and also at World and European Championships as well the Commonwealth Games. One of her career highlights to date was winning an individual Bronze medal at the Beijing Olympics for the 400m freestyle. Joanne has also won individual and relay medals at World/European Championships and the Commonwealth Games and is a former world record holder for the 400m freestyle.

Jo will be leading a sponsored fitness circuit with all pupils, and will follow-up with a talk and question and answer session. The aim of the event is to inspire the pupils to take up sport generally, but just as importantly to encourage them to discover and then pursue their passion in life.

As the sponsorship form and online sponsorship page explain, much of the money that is raised will be used to buy sports equipment for the school, while also supporting GB athletes (including Paralympic athletes). Please also make sure that your child/children come to school on the event day with their PE Kits! Thank you in anticipation of creating a terrific and memorable event.
